## Katharine House Hospice Midnight Walk Saturday 25 June

To tie in with the  $25^{th}$  anniversary of the opening of the hospice, the walk will have a 'silver' theme. It starts from Banbury Cricket Club in Bodicote and follows a 10 mile circular route along well-marshalled and well-lit streets around Banbury. The event is open to adults and children aged 12 years and over. (Each child under 17 years must be accompanied by an adult.) Entry fee is £20 (non-refundable) which includes a t-shirt, medal and refreshments – *discounted early bird entry fee of £15 before 30 April!* All participants are asked to raise a minimum of £25 sponsorship (families £50) to help fund the hospice services. Mrs Chadbourne will be participating in the walk and she would be very happy if you were able to sponsor her!
