### **FRITWELL CHURCH OF ENGLAND SCHOOL UNIFORM**

Fritwell School has school uniform policy and all pupils attending the school are expected to wear our school uniform. School uniform is important as it plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of a school and setting an appropriate tone. It instils pride; supports positive behaviour and discipline; ensures pupils of all races and backgrounds feel welcome; protects children from social pressures to dress in a particular way; nurtures cohesion and promotes good relations between different groups of pupils. Our school uniform policy is as follows:

Light grey trousers Navy Fritwell school sweatshirt with school logo. White shirt or white polo shirt with school logo. Sensible black or navy school shoes (no trainers or boots). Plain grey or navy socks (not patterned)  <b>Optional Summer Wear</b> Light grey shorts White school polo shirt with school logo or short sleeved white shirt. Grey or navy socks. Sensible black or navy school shoes (no trainers). Closed in sandals only may be worn.	Light grey skirt or trousers Navy Fritwell school sweatshirt with school logo Navy Fritwell school cardigan with school logo. White blouse or a white polo shirt with school logo. Sensible black or navy school shoes (no trainers or boots). Plain navy or white socks or navy or grey tights.(not patterned)  <b>Optional Summer Wear –</b> Light grey skirt or Blue gingham dress White school polo shirt with school logo or white short sleeved blouse. White socks. Sensible black or navy school shoes (no trainers). Closed in sandals only may be worn.
<b>PE</b> Navy sports shorts and navy T-shirts with school logo (no team logos) with trainers in a school navy drawstring PE bag-no backpacks are permitted due to space in cloakrooms Year 3-6 will need either football boots or trainers for outdoor use which must be kept in a drawstring PE bag. Navy track suits may be worn in cold weather.	
<b>HAIR</b> Any hair which reaches the shoulder must be tied back with scrunchies and hairbands, clips in school colours i.e. navy, grey or white.	
<b>JEWELLERY</b> No jewellery is permitted, except for watches. Pupils are responsible for looking after these.
