Topic: The Secret Garden

This term we will be focussing on life processes and living things, and learning more about animals and plants.

English: The children will be reading a number of different texts related to our topic, and then writing stories, information texts, book reviews, letters, emails and diary entries based on these. Texts: Eddie's Garden by Sarah Garland, The Tiny Seed by Eric Carle, Oliver's Vegetables by Vivian French, and The Global Garden by Kate Perry and Jennie Maizels.

Maths: Number and Place Value; Mental Addition and Subtraction; Problem Solving, reasoning and algebra; Measurements; Statistics; Mental multiplication and division; Fractions, ratio and proportion.

RE: What is the best way for a Jew to show commitment to God?

PE: Tennis and Swimming

Music: Singing and performing songs from different genres (e.g. R&B, Motown, Musicals).

Science: The life cycle of flowering plants, and the basic needs of animals (including humans) for survival.

ICT: Film making
