Topic work: Our topic title this term is “Near and Far,” which will link to Geography, Art, Computing, English and History. During the topic we hope to answer the following questions: Where are we? Where are the different countries, regions, counties and cities of the UK? What are these places like? What key mountains, hills, coastlines, lakes and rivers does the UK have? We will be learning how to read maps, and using them to pinpoint places that we have visited. We will also be learning more about the history of St. Olave’s Church.

Other subjects: We will be working on reggae songs and rhythms in music, our P.E. focus is invasion games (football), in R.E. the children will be finding out more about Judaism, and in Maths we will be looking at number and place value, addition and subtraction, measure and shape, multiplication and division and simple fractions.
