Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been another busy week in school with children in class and at home doing some super work. Our "live" sessions on MS Teams has been working well; you will now see that the children are being asked to wait in the lobby area before being admitted. This is to ensure that the children do not mistakenly start the meetings and also to safeguard everyone.

On Monday (18th), I am going to run a whole School Worship via Teams at 2.45pm. All children will receive an invitation and it will appear on their calendar. This will replace the story time session in Sticklebacks, Seahorses, Stingrays and Sharks.

After having successfully set up the provision for remote learning, we are now in a position to roll out some additional support, in line with our normal school provision, for those children who may have extra educational needs. These families are being contacted directly to explain the level of support.
