

Admissions Statement For 2025 - 2026

The Eynsham Partnership Academy (EPA) is the Admissions Authority for all Trust schools, and the Trust and its schools are required by their Funding Agreements to comply with the Schools Admissions Code. The responsibility for the administration of an individual EPA school's admissions has been delegated by EPA to each school's Local Governing Body (LGB). All admissions policies, procedures and approaches must be in line with the DfE Code of Practice and the advice of the Diocese of Oxford for our Church schools.

The primary responsibilities of the LGB are to review and recommend for approval to the Trust Board any proposed changes to their school admissions and to ensure that pupils are admitted to the school in line with the policies and procedures above.

The EPA Trust Board will take responsibility for supporting schools with any decisions over changes to individual school admissions and will discuss this with Oxfordshire County Council, and the Diocese of Oxford for Church schools.

EPA schools participate in the in-year admissions arrangements for Oxfordshire County Council and the position of the Trust is for the Local Governing Bodies to use the Local Authority admissions team to administer the admissions process (with the exception of Nursery and Sixth Form applications).

As outlined in Section 2.7 of the 2015 Code of Practice on Admissions: 2.7 Admission authorities must allocate places on the basis of their determined admission arrangements only, and a decision to offer or refuse admission must not be made by one individual in an admission authority.

Applications to attend any EPA school are welcomed from all families.
