Class Activities

Tiddlers & Minnows

As part of their learning in Black History Month, the Tiddlers and Minnows have been researching Rosa Parks. They read the 'Little People, Big Dreams' book about Rosa Parks and discovered how she fought to change something that was unfair. They also enjoyed their Forest School lesson with Mr Pemble; he changed some of the rules to their favourite Forest School games as a way of building their resilience and leadership. The Minnows have also been learning about Patterns in Maths and have been creating and completing their own repeated AB patterns using colours and shapes.

Sticklebacks

The children enjoyed their dance and drama workshops earlier this week when they learnt about Rosa Parks and the impact of her actions on her community, and they learnt an African dance. The children responded positively to the school visitors.

As part of their education on Black History Month they have focused on the story of Floella Benjamin's life and how she came to England from Trinidad. The children have written short biographies about her.

Seahorses

Seahorses really enjoyed our workshops on black history drama and African dance this week. In PE their



agility was put to the test in their dodging game and they have started writing a narrative about a setting that they've never been in before which has really put their imagination to the test.



Stingrays

Following on from on the drama workshop on Monday, which helped the Stingrays understand the importance of Black History Month, they have been using Floella Benjamin's autobiography to further develop their understanding of the 'Windrush generation'. In art this week they were inspired by the African dance workshop to look at the artwork of Lois Mailou Jones and have started to produce some excellent oil pastel work using her pictures for ideas. 


Class Activities (continued)
